





Responses It's been challenging for many children to receive services over the phone as many don't like this communication method. Our services have been much shorter in duration. However, as a program, our direct service percentage has increased by 10-20%.

We are not a direct service providing agency. However it has been extremely difficult to get services started during the COVID19.

Essex County Mental Health was designated for OLP but I do not believe we are anymore.

Some families have indicated that they would prefer not to do telehealth but are still interesed in receiving services.

Certainly challenging, some services are not easily provided via telehealth

The relaxation of Medicaid standards for Telehealth have allowed us to provide needed Behavioral Health services across the state.

Telehealth has been very helpful to serve individuals and families in this area .
