Annual and intermediate plans for addiction services:

1. Create a Crisis Response Team that includes at least a Therapist and Peer to respond to crises in the county. An on-call provider would assist in complex needs.

2. Provide Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) for all appropriate consumers.

3. Develop and increase community coalitions for recovery and prevention, including the efforts to expand AIR (Adventures in Recovery) Cattaraugus, a Recovery Center Organization (RCO).

4. Expand Systems of Care (SOC) to educate and train volunteers to serve any of the 3 oversight agencies (Addictions Services & Supports, Developmental Disabilities, and Mental Health).

Annual and intermediate plans for <u>developmental disability</u> services:

1. Create a Crisis Response Team that includes at least a Therapist and Peer to respond to crises in the county. An on-call provider would assist in complex needs, while collaborating with OPWDD to ensure appropriate response.

2. Sustainability plans for Developmental Disabilities Providers in County to build and maintain integrated community centers and/or recreational facilities.

3. Increase access to services for I/DD, including respite.

4. Expand Systems of Care (SOC) to educate and train volunteers to serve any of the 3 oversight agencies (Addictions Services & Supports, Developmental Disabilities, and Mental Health).

Annual and intermediate plans for mental health services:

 Create a Crisis Response Team that includes at least a Therapist and Peer to respond to crises in the county. An on-call provider would assist in complex needs.
Hire and maintain OASAS-certified staff in the mental health counseling center, which is expanding into an integrated clinic.

3. Develop and increase community coalitions for health and wellness.

4. Expand Systems of Care (SOC) to educate and train volunteers to serve any of the 3 oversight agencies (Addictions Services & Supports, Developmental Disabilities, and Mental Health).

Although that service is available to Cattaraugus County individuals, the respite agency is not always able to provide transportation and seldom collaborates with the individual's Cattaraugus County providers. Cattaraugus County would explore options for an integrated clinic to serve individuals with addictions, mental health, and developmental disabilities diagnoses.

Yes Need Applies to: Both Youth and Adults Need description (Optional): All the State moneys poured into DPS (Direct Providers of Services) and HWB (Healthcare Worker Bonus) incentives do not seem to be changing retention of long-term employment status. Some of those workers may lose other services, i.e., childcare or Medicaid, if their income exceeds identified thresholds, but the bonuses do not sustain their needs. Goal would be to

increase the workforce to meet client needs in creative ways that have become necessary as a result of COVID. Additionally, State mandates for additional services affect the already strained labor markets; i.e., State-mandated MAT services in Jails draws CASAC staff candidates from other SUD treatment facilities.
