Annual and intermediate plans for addiction services:

Goals for Addiction Services in Chautauqua County include Provide Comprehensive Integrated Outpatient Treatment Programs; Delivering Services to Incarcerated Individuals; Developing and Supporting Behavioral Health Workforce; Supporting People in Recovery through Housing Support Continuum.

To meet these goals, in 2023, CCDMH will work to across the continuum of providers in line with the goals of CCMH's CCBHC Improvement and Advancement grant goals. These include, but are not limited to:

Decrease by 10% post emergency department and behavioral health hospitalization visits by coordinating with local hospitals and county jail to design transition plan for discharged/released patients/incarcerated individuals.

Annual and intermediate plans for developmental disability services:

In 2023, CCDMH will work across the continuum of providers to identify and meet the needs and person centered goals for our community members.

Intermediately, the Community Services Board will re-establish a Developmental Disability Sub-Committee to improve access, quality, and integration of services and supports for individuals with developmental disabilities and their families and to decrease health and educational disparities experienced by people with developmental disabilities.

Annual and intermediate plans for mental health services:

Goals for Mental Health Services in Chautauqua County will be in line with the goals of CCMH's CCBHC Improvement and Advancement grant goals. These include, but are not limited to:

Collaborate with key County stakeholders to create a taskforce to identify high utilizers, system gaps, and solutions. With more comprehensive lethality risk assessment training

and competency, and Peer involvement in crisis planning, reduce CCBHC client suicide attempts by 20%.

Enhance the continuum of crisis behavioral health services for those who are at imminent risk of having a psychiatric or substance use related crisis. Increase child/youth school-based interventions by developing a specialized child/adolescent mobile crisis services team.

Care coordination will have decreased gaps in consumer's care by 10% each of two years due to ensuring consumers attend physical health appointments and preventative screenings, and are receiving metabolic screenings and monitoring.
