
Housing Workgroup

Highlights:

- HUD/housing choice vouchers can be secured in a timely manner. The continued challenge is finding affordable housing.
- OMH bed occupancy is at 75-99%
- Home ownership assistance is provided for mortgage/back taxes, repairs and home loans as well as financial counseling
- Barriers to homeowners ranked health issues #4 of the 5. Affordability and then down payment/savings were #1 and #2.
- Future plans (1- 5yrs) for new units 5 answered yes. Respondents also provided funding resources/ranking:
 - 65% Low-income housing tax credits
 - 16% Traditional Mortgage
 - 13% Federal funding (HOME Investment Partnership, Community Block Grant)
 - 8% Tax Credits other (clean energy, historic housing, etc.)
 - 1% Foundations/trusts

Highlights:


- Established in August 2020
